

A collective commitment to reduce road deaths by 50% by 2020

As you are aware, there has been a steep increase in the number of road fatalities over the past two months. In August 14 children lost their lives in Knysna, after boarding an overloaded school bus. The driver also didn't survive. Last month, a family died on the notorious Moloto Road in Pretoria, it is alleged that the occupants of the car were not wearing safety belts.

In light of this, Transport Minister Sibusiso Ndebele has vowed to take tougher action on motorists, who break road rules. As a result, at least 1,500 un-roadworthy buses and taxis have been taken off South Africa's roads, following Minister Ndebele's instruction on 31 August that every bus and taxi must be stopped and checked.

The Minister also re-affirmed South Africa's support to the United Nations Decade of Action on Road Safety, which aims to cut road deaths and injuries by 50 percent in the next ten years.
